The Gospel in Isaiah

FIRST: Of Himself, or Another? (Acts 8:29-35)

Question: Was Jesus in the Prophet, Isaiah's mind when he spoke of Isaiah's suffering servant?

Answer: The Rabbis say no; the context says yes! Cp, Isaiah 51:1,2; 17:21 through Chapter 25.

Isaiah knew that he spoke of Messiah's ransom for Israel's redemption; Messiah's life

for Israel's atonement.
